The enviable collection seldom seen in Australia features over 100 paintings and bronzes from London the Boyd dynasty private collection and few from Bundanon. It's rare to amalgamate the collection of such significance.

A once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for art lovers entail the previously unseen Arthur Boyd iconic *Lost Bride* circa 1955 that was hidden for almost six decades for the first time on public viewing.

In August 2011 Sotheby's fetch \$1.2 million for Boyd's *Freighted Bridegroom* mid-size board.
